A very special bigband, including 8 French horns. Stan Kenton was the first to lead such a bigband with an additional French horn section in the USA. Rudi Mazač, himself a famed French horn soloist also uses this extrasound.

ACK VAN ROOYEN

Legendary Trumpet and Flugelhorn Player/Composer Member of many famous orchestras such as: The Kenny Clarke/Francy Boland Big Band, The United Jazz & Rock Ensemble, Bert Kaempfert Orchestra, Clark Terry/Gil Evans Orchestra, Aimé Barelli Orchestra, SFB Bigband Berlin, SDR Orchestra Stuttgart, Together with Wolfgang Dauner and Albert Mangelsdorff he toured Asia and South America. Presently Ack is based in Holland, where he works with his own quintet, the Dutch Jazz Orchestra, the Jazz orchestra of the Concertgebouw and in Duo with Joerg Reiter. He teaches the Royal Conservatory of the Hague and leads workshops and coaches Bigbands throughout Europe.

SYDNEY ELLIS, vocalist

Sydney began her singing career in the Los Angeles area. The dream comes true. Since then, her singing has blossomed into an obsession for what Sydney calls, her Cultural Heritage, or African- American Folk Music. The rest of the world calls it Blues, Classic Jazz, Gospel, Spirituals, New Orleans Jazz & Blues, R & B, Chicago Blues & Kansas City Blues. This obsession has taken her in 3 short years from the Los Angeles area to Europe. Since 1995, Sydney has performed over 1,000 concerts in 25 countries: Germany, Switzerland, Poland, Netherlands, Spain, France, Denmark, Belgium, Luxemburg, Norway, Georgia, Finland, Bulgaria, Serbia, Hungary, Tunisia, Croatia, Ukraine, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Sweden, Italy, Austria and Ireland.

trumpet, flugelhorn, composer and arranger was born in 1931 in Jajce. He studied at the Music Academy in Belgrade from 1948 to 1953. As a youth he played with several swing and Dixie bands. He went to Germany and in 1956 he made his first record as a member of the Frankfurt All-Stars. In addition to being the band's premier trumpet soloist, he performed with such greats as Stan Getz, Chet Baker, Oscar Pettiford, Lucky Thompson, Herb Pomeroy, Count Basie, Stan Kenton, Duke Ellington, Maynard Ferguson, Francy Boland, Kurt Edelhagen, Max Greger, Woody Herman, Mal Waldron, Rob Pronk, Jerry van Rooyen, Nathan Davis, Dizzy Gillespie, Gerry Mulligan, Clark Terry, Rolf Ericson, Lee Konitz, Sonny Rollins, Phil Woods, Dexter Gordon, Thad Jones-Mel Lewis, Slide Hampton and many others...
